KUWAIT CITY, Jan 1: Boushahri Art Gallery will be holding an art exhibition by Liz Strick titled 'Memories' Jan 13 at 7 pm. The artist from the Netherlands is known for her expressionist techniques and rich chiaroscuro depic-tions of a variety of themes. Liz Strick's formative years were spent in Turkey where she apprenticed under Orhan Taylan, whose expres-sionist techniques influenced her style. Later, while living in London, she worked in the studio of Oliver Bevan for three years. By taking part in his workshops she was able to hone her skills in oil painting and printmak-She has being holding solo exhibtisions since 1994 and her works embellish many private collections in Australia, Curacao, Canada, Germany, Turkey, Lebanon, The Netherlands, UAE, the UK and the USA. Her last solo exhibition was the 'Lebanon Series' and it explores from her unique perspective Lebanon after the recent war. Speaking about it she remarked: "The birth of my second grandchild is what brought me back to Beirut. During my stay I visited the South of the country as far as Litani River." Those four days she spent visiting the country had a tremendous impact on her and her act, "and it was especially apparent upon my return when I started to revisit my experiences."
She says she learnt a lot about the Lebanese people and their culture. "Their hospitality and strong personalities have made a longlasting impression on me. Witnessing some of the tremendous damages of the war, the pain this has caused and the ongoing political instabilities have all added to my desire to try and put some of my feelings on the canvas. That was the beginning of the Lebanon Series."

It was her tribute to the small great nation. Open Atelier in 2007, Water paintings in 2004, Louis ffure in 2003, Dialog mit der Selee in 2000, Betten Tischer in 1999 and Klavierhaus Claudo Labiance in 1999 are some of her other exhibitions. Her first exhibition was held in Turkey in 1994. It was called Akbank Sanat Galerisi. Free brush strokes with more emphasis on light and shade


